- 3. <u>Understand the Regulations</u>: Dietary supplements are regulated by the FDA under GMP (Good Manufacturing Practices). That means proper documentation, testing, and facility certifications your manufacturer must be up to code.
- 4. <u>Source Ingredients & Packaging</u>: You'll need to decide what kind of ingredients, containers, caps, scoops, and labels your product requires. Your manufacturer can handle sourcing of these elements.
- 5. <u>Get a Quote & Choose Your Manufacturer</u>: Choose a manufacturing partner who is transparent about timelines, pricing, and quality. Look for NSF or GMP certifications and make sure they communicate clearly from day one.
- 6. <u>Approve Samples</u>: Before full production begins, you'll likely get samples to test flavor, appearance, texture, and performance. This is your chance to dial it in.
- 7. <u>Manufacture, Test, Package & Ship</u>: Once everything is approved, your product enters production. It's manufactured, tested for quality, packaged, and shipped to your fulfillment center or warehouse.
